Air Force Instruction (AFI) 63-125 is supplemented as follows: It implements policy on Nuclear Certified Equipment (NCE) Program to ACC wings. This supplement applies to military and civilian personnel at all levels, including Air Force Reserve and Air National Guard (ANG) units, involved in research, design, development, testing, acquisition, operation, maintenance, and modification of nuclear weapons and their related systems and subsystems. It applies to ACC wings which operate, maintain, acquire, sustain, or modify specialized and non-specialized equipment/vehicles listed in the Master Nuclear Certification List (MNCL) at <https://wwwmil.nwc.kirtland.af.mil/MNCL/index.cfm>. Ensure that all records created as a result of this publication are in accordance with (IAW) AFMAN 33-363, *Management of Records*, and dispose of them IAW the Air Force Records Disposition Schedule. Contact supporting records managers as required. Send comments and suggested improvements, for this publication, through channels using AF Form 847, *Recommendation for Change of Publication*, to HQ ACC/A10 Strategic Deterrence & Nuclear Integration Directorate. This supplement may be further supplemented.

SUMMARY OF CHANGES

This document is substantially changed and must be completely reviewed. A new chapter has been added identifying items that are required to be nuclear certified before being used with nuclear weapons or nuclear weapon systems. A new chapter has been added describing the Master Nuclear Certification List (MNCL) and the criteria for listing items in the MNCL.

Organizational names have been updated to reflect changes since the original publication. Interim Change 1 has been incorporated into the revision. Training requirements have been clarified, process owner roles and responsibilities have been clarified, and additional definitions have been incorporated into the glossary.

2.7.13.1. ACC/A10A, Assessments Division, will manage the NCE Program for ACC.

2.7.13.1.1. Wing, Group, Squadron or GSU commanders with assigned NCE will designate, by letter, primary and alternate unit NCE monitors. Additionally, wings may establish an overall POC for their NCE Program. NCE monitor designation letters will be submitted to the ACC NCE Program Manager, acca10a@langley.af.mil.

2.7.13.1.2. Unit NCE Monitors or wing POCs will submit initial baseline and annual survey results to the ACC NCE Program Manager, acca10a@langley.af.mil. Surveys will be conducted using the positive ID criteria listed in MNCL General Guidance.
